- Improved access to justice of victims of abuse and violence, especially women and girls with disabilities and other vulnerable groups

- Improved education, awareness-raising and women's participation in gender-responsive climate change adaptation and disaster risk reduction and management towards building resilient communities
- Institutionalized provision of women and child-friendly spaces in evacuation centers

- More positive portrayal of women in all forms of media
